

Author, teacher, world traveler, geographer, and philanthropist are all terms that apply to **FRANK DOUGLAS**.

A native of Janesville, **FRANK** attended the city schools and is a graduate of UW-Madison. After combat service in Europe during World War II he returned to become a teacher - seven years in Deerfield and thirty years at Janesville Senior and Craig High Schools. He also taught for five years at UWC-Rock County. In 1985 **FRANK** was named Wisconsin High School Teacher of the Year!

Over many years of world travel **FRANK** spent time in 128 different countries. Many audiences have enjoyed his travel lectures. His classroom decor that reflected the region or country being studied became legendary.

FRANK established his Living Scholarships whereby seventy of his "boys" traveled with him over a period of forty years.
