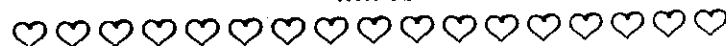
## IDD Chairman— Jim Clark

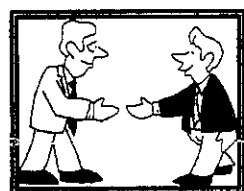
The \$10 you turn in as a result of the ticket sales helps 200 children plus it makes your buyers eligible for over 100 fantastic prizes.

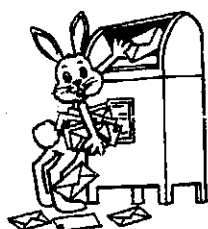
