The Raffle money is coming in strong. If you haven't turned your money or tickets in you can do so up to August 1st. Fantastic prizes and over 100 of them!

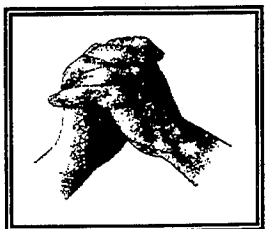

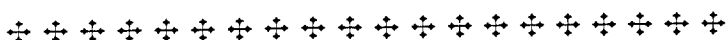

Russell F. Hegge.....

Russ, a long time member of Janesville Kiwanis Clubs died quietly at his home, Wed., April 26, 2000. He was very active in the Noon Club since 1965 and a member of the New Club Building Committee that founded the Golden "K" Club; subsequently joining Golden "K" on May 15, 1991. Russ served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and was active in veterans organizations. He served several years as Rock County Sheriff and Undersheriff.
