**Actions:**

1. Len Griffith reporting on Plans for Administrative Budget Study Committee informed us that a committee composed of John Dooley, Will Reck, Fred Wiltse and himself has been formed and will report at the next Board Meeting.
2. Approved sending budgeted \$7,000 to IDD International. Money collected from this date on at the refreshment table will go to IDD.
3. Reported that Russ Hegge Memorial Gifts disposition is as follows:  
\$1,000 to Service Account  
260 to Memorial Fund  
80 to Administrative Account
4. Approved Giles Clark (sponsored by Jim Clark), for membership. To be inducted June 12, 2000.
5. Reported that 3 delegates are budgeted to go to the District Convention in Milwaukee on August 4-6, 2000. Delegates are: George McKilligan, Len Griffith, and Pete Kealey
6. President George presented a review of several of the Proposed Resolutions to be presented at the International Convention in Miami FL June 23-27. Discussion was lively.
7. President George reported that SON has found it necessary to increase our refreshment cost per person from \$2 to \$2.50 to offset higher food costs. This proposal has been referred to the House Maintenance Committee for recommendation at the July Board Meeting.
8. Chuck Wanninger reported on a proposal to place mile posts on the Kiwanis trails. This would need to be a joint project with the Noon Club. It was approved turning over this proposal to a liaison committee with the Noon Club.
9. It was approved presenting a letter opener with the Kiwanis Logo in lieu of a Parker Pen to future program speakers.

Parenting The 1<sup>st</sup> Year Letter

On May 24, 2000, 13 Golden "K" and 7 Noon Club Kiwanians prepared 1,177 Parenting Letters for mailing. 2,354 individuals benefited from this project. This makes a total of 40 man-hours for the month.
