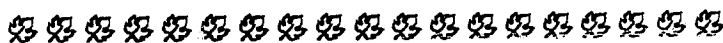


From the President's Desk

On August 16th, you will be asked to approve an increase of our weekly meeting fee from \$2.00 to \$3.00. Your Board of Directors approved this unanimously. 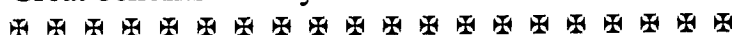
