

**From the President's Desk**

On August 16<sup>th</sup>, you will be asked to approve an increase of our weekly meeting fee from \$2.00 to \$3.00. Your Board of Directors approved this unanimously. 






**COMMUNITY SERVICES**

**Oliver Peter Baukol.....Age 88**

Peter was born in Lyle, WA, Aug. 1, 1912, and died in Janesville July 20, 2000. He was a member of Golden "K" from 9-25-91 to 7-17-96. He withdrew from the Club due to illness. He was a long time member of Kiwanis, having also been affiliated in Colorado and Illinois.
