ANNUAL MEETING

On Wednesday, May 9, The Blackhawk Golden "K" will hold its Annual Meeting at which time all officers and Directors, except the Secretary, will be elected to office. They will serve from October 1, 2001 to September 30, 2002.

The Nominating Committee consists of five club members, the majority of which, according to the Kiwanis Bylaws, must be Past Presidents. Those serving on the Nominating Committee are: The Rev. George McKilligin, Chairman, Will Reck, Joel Moore, Rich McMullen and Tom Albanese.

At least two weeks before the annual meeting, the Nominating Committee must submit the following:

1. The President-elect as its sole nominee for President.
2. A list of nominees, not to exceed two for each office to be filled.
3. A list of nominees for director, not to exceed the number (in our case, two) of Directors to be elected, plus three.

At least one week before the Annual Meeting, nominations from the floor may be made for any office, the names of which are added to the list submitted by the Nominating Committee..

On the day of The Annual Meeting, the election will take place and the votes cast by written ballot. The Club President will appoint an Election Committee, comprised of seven club members, to distribute ballots and count the votes.

Within one week of The Annual Meeting, the Board of Directors will elect the Club Secretary.
