



BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SON, July, 2002

Special Meeting, July 10, 2002

A special meeting called to discuss a dues increase

President Kealey presented a very comprehensive study of the objectives of Kiwanis as regards goals, sending delegates to conventions, costs, the necessity of dues, the process of dues determination and whether a dues increase is appropriate at this time.

After considerable discussion an annual dues increase of \$20 was approved.

Discussion and Actions:

1. Fiscal Responsibility Regarding Conventions— The focus of this issue was on a Policy Statement [defining limits for expense reimbursement of delegates to International and District Conventions] generated by a committee appointed by President Kealey. Prior to the discussion John Holcomb addressed the Board with concerns about a previous Board's expense disbursements for the delegates attending the 2001 International Convention in Taiwan. George McKilligin then presented the Policy Statement. Considerable discussion ensued. A vote was taken and the Policy Statement was unanimously approved. John Holcomb expressed satisfaction with the Statement.
2. Dave Knoerr gave a report on the Kiwanis Trail. He recommended that Golden "K" join with the Noon Club to do trail maintenance. He indicated that he will consult the Noon Club and advise President Kealey on scheduling maintenance time.
3. Karl Petter of YCPO reported that funds were needed for printing sets. He was advised to go ahead and order as this expense was budgeted.
4. Following the General Meeting the Board Meeting was reconvened and Ray Anderson and Joel Moore were approved as delegates to District Convention.
