



In Memoriam

John Gimla age 87, died 8-3-2002 in Janesville. He was born in Milwaukee on Aug. 24, 1914. John graduated from West Milwaukee High School in 1933 and from Carroll College in 1937. He served in the US Army in the Pacific Theater during World War II. John married Ann Oertwig on June 22, 1941 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bloomington, Illinois. A Janesville resident since 1942, John retired from General Motors in 1972, where he had worked for many years, most of them as paymaster. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, the Southern Wisconsin Gladiola Society, and the Blackhawk Golden "K" Kiwanis [2-1-84—9-30-01], not renewing his membership due to failing health. He enjoyed golf and bowling. He is survived by his wife and relatives. Funeral Services were held at St. Paul's Church on 8-7-02. Interment was at Oak Hill Cemetery.




YCPO—Parenting
