## In Memoriam

**Robert J. Stewart**

Robert [Bob] J. Stewart, age 84, of 2021 Bond Place, died Mon, Jan 27, 2003 at home. He was born, Oct 8, 1918 in Gettysburg, SD. Bob graduated from high school in Baraboo, WI, and in his senior year he played on a high school football team that was undefeated and never scored upon. He also attended UW-La Crosse. A Janesville resident since 1940. His wife preceded him in death [June 6, 1999]. Bob served in the 32<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division from 1940 to 1945 with the 192 Tank Battalion Co. A, the "Janesville 99." He was a prisoner of war of the Japanese Imperial Army for four years and was a survivor of the Bataan Death March. He was employed as a rural mail carrier until retirement. Bob was a charter member of St. William Catholic Church. He held membership in the V.F.W., Chap. of ExPOW's, Loyal Order of Moose and the Golden "K" Kiwanis. He is survived by 3 children, 10 grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, a brother and his beloved dog, Holly. Mass of Christian burial 11 AM at St. William Catholic Church. Interment—Milton Lawns Memorial Park [Military Rites].
