What is the purpose of Kiwanis? It is to improve the quality of life for children and families worldwide!!!

Starting in April, we have the opportunity to fulfill this purpose for children in Janesville. The Ronald McDonald Dental Care Mobile will be here to provide dental service to uninsured and under funded school age children. The unit is a self-contained dental lab provided by McDonald Charities of Madison and the UW Children's Hospital along with the Rockford Health System.

The Janesville School System will help find dental patients. Some of them will need transportation to and from the CareMobile.

Here is where we can help. We need volunteers to drive the patients back and forth. Drivers are needed for the first two weeks in April and again for two weeks in May. Routes and times will be determined by the Rock Co. Health Department. Hours will be approximately 8:15 - 10:00 AM and 1:00 - 4:00 PM.

The CareMobile will be located at the YWCA CARE HOUSE on Conde St, Janesville [near Edison Middle School].

This project will not cost our club a single dime! We should be able to volunteer our time and vehicles to this meaningful community-wide event. If your wives are so inclined, they are more than welcome to take part also.

On March 12, our speaker will be Helen Krause, from the Rock County Health Department. She can answer questions that you might have.




