

53 members, Gert Bell, my wife Peggy and daughter Kathryn put in a total of 186 hours to make our 2003 Peanut Days successful.


With our collections at 12 sites on Friday and 11 sites on Saturday, our sale of leftover peanuts, and our canister collections of \$59.70, we collected a total of:






