Trash Cleanup of:
Kiwanis Trail, Park & Pond



To keep the Kiwanis name in a good light and reputation, our club "adopted" the Kiwanis Trail. We entered into an agreement with the City Parks Dept. To clean the Trail of the trash and litter periodically as needed and to do this as a joint project with the Noon Kiwanis Club. Eleven of our members did a "K-Trail" cleanup on March 31, 2004.
