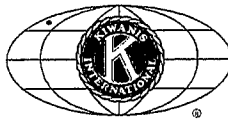

around 150. Fewer members mean less rest.

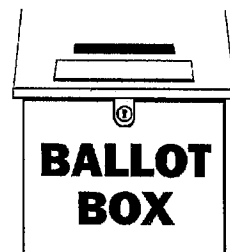
Have you invited a friend, relative or neighbor
