### BLOOD-MOBILE

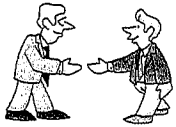

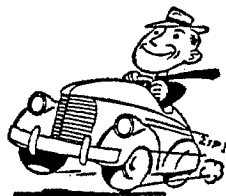
We need you all to keep asking potential new members to visit our club to keep us strong and viable.
