**TREE SALE SUMMARY**

As most of you already know, for the first time we sold two different kinds of trees. While we ordered the same amount of trees as last year [10,000], this year we had 7,000 blue spruce and 3,000 arborvitae. While this made it a bit harder to keep track of how many we had sold previous to the pickup date, we feel that selling both kinds is of advantage to us. We sold all of the blue spruce, 2,350 of the arborvitae, and gave 500 arborvitae to the Boy Scouts and 50 to the 4-H Club [this was done around noon when it looked as if we would not be able to sell them all].
