Board of Director's Meeting 7-25-07

Meeting called to order @7:58 am by President Phil.
Members present: Selgren, Knudson, Reck, Larson, Guernsey, Draheim, Petter and Flanagan.
Others Present: Ron Devine, Ray Anderson and Fred Wiltsie.
..... Secretary's report of 6-27-07 as a motion and approved.
..... Treasurer's report submitted and discussed. Motion made by Reck, 2nd by Flanagan to file. motion approved.
..... Phil Selgren stated that we have 3 potential members that he is following up with.
..... Phil Selgren stated that the Smoke Signal is still in limbo. Don Eckert is still working correcting some computer problems. Don should have an August issue.
..... Phil Selgren stated we need to elect delegates for the 9-7-07 district convention. Motion made by Guernsey, seconded by Reck to send Selgren and Knudson as delegates. Motion approved.
..... Motion made by Reck, seconded by Flanagan to send Richard Johnson as a 3rd delegate. Approved.
..... Reimbursement to the International Convention was discussed. Bob Knudson proposed changing 80% for lodging and travel to 100%. Also, requested that the cost of transportation by taxi, bus, etc; should be reimbursed. After much discussion it was determined the policy cannot be changed for this year. Any action will be taken by the new board in October.
..... New member induction fee was discussed. After much discussion the motion failed. Again, this proposed policy change needs to be addressed by the new board in October.
