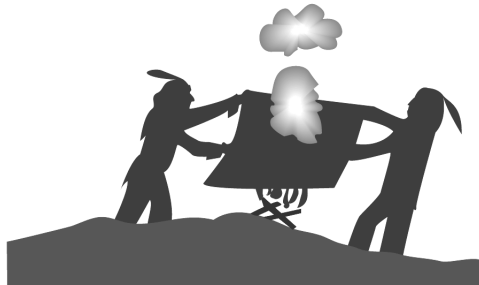

The Mid-Winter Conference on 2-22 to 2-24 will be attended by Bob Knudson and Rich Johnson.

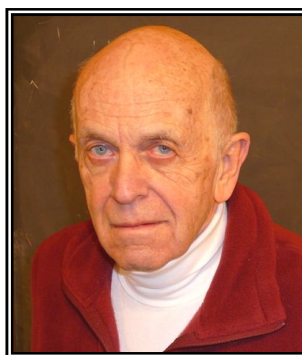
Bob Knudson adjourned the meeting at 8:55 AM.

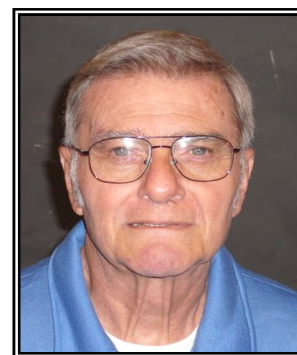
