

Meeting 02-27-08

Secretary's report of 1-30-08 submitted at an earlier date. Motion made by John Orland and seconded by Will Reck to approve the secretary's report as submitted. Motion approved.

Treasurer's report was submitted and discussed by Will Reck. Will noted that there was no action in the service account. The income for the Truck on Ice project is \$14,100 and the net amount at this time is \$5,235. The final figures will be presented at the next board meeting. Motion made by Will Reck, seconded by Fred Adams to file the treasurer's report as submitted. Motion approved.

Bob Knudson announced the resignation of Don Eckert as the "Smoke Signal" editor. Don will not continue as editor for health reasons. Dave Peterson will replace Don as editor of the "Smoke Signal" and the "Kiwanis Blackhawk Golden K" website. John Orland will stay on as assistant editor.
