

The school began its programs in Sept. 2007 and has graduated 41 students who benefited from the credit rescue curriculum.

The Wishing Well project was discussed at great length. The decision was to wait for further action until after the April 9th regular club meeting, although, Bill Bessire will pursue a potential location.


Bob Knudson adjourned the meeting @8:52 am.


