



If you have not visited the site, you will find:

- A **History of the Club** concerning our origin, charter members, key events, current officers, and board members.
- A **Current Membership** list, along with pictures of new members (*for those of us who are challenged matching faces to names*).
- A **Bulletin Board** to post information on upcoming events and information (pictures, videos, summaries) about recent activities. At the bottom of the page is a link to contact me with updates.
- A current **Listing of Programs** scheduled for our Wednesday meetings.
- **Smoke Signals** for the current month, as well as an archive of those for the last 2 years. This is especially handy for those out of town or unable to attend weekly meetings.

- A **Committee List** with a description of their function and chair responsibilities.
- A page of **Popular Links** to other web sites in the community and Kiwanis clubs & resources.
- A "**Contact Us**" page to make it easy for anyone in the community having a question or interested in obtaining more information about our club.

The correct way to reach our web site is to **enter the web address directly into the address window of your browser**. Once there, just save it as a favorite and you will not have to type the address in again.
