

Secretary's report of 10-28-09 was submitted at an earlier date. Motion made by Tony Guernsey, seconded by Gordon Drake to approve minutes as submitted. *Motion approved*

Will Reck stated that the audit for 2008/2009 had been completed. Will made a motion, seconded by Gordon Drake to approve the 2008/2009 financial reports. *Motion approved*

Under old business we had a policy review:

Policy attachment #12 on new member dues was discussed and was deemed satisfactory. Motion made by Gordon Drake, seconded by Will Reck to approve the new member's dues schedule. *Motion approved*

Policy attachment #14 on perfect attendance was discussed. Motion made by Gordon Drake, seconded by Richard Johnson to leave unchanged. *Motion approved*

Policy attachment #15, concerning expense reimbursement, was reviewed with a decision to leave unchanged. Motion made by Gordon Drake, seconded by Richard Johnson to approve as is. *Motion approved*

Policy attachment #16, guest meeting fee, was reviewed and left unchanged. Motion made by Gordon Drake, seconded by John Nevins to approve as is. *Motion approved*

Policy attachment #17, a new policy concerning the creation of "**Friends of Kiwanis**" was discussed in detail. This covers any non-Kiwanians who have assisted the Blackhawk Golden "K" Kiwanis Club in a significant way. They may be named a "Friend of Kiwanis" for one year by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Motion made by Will Reck, seconded by Richard Johnson to approve. *Motion approved*

Pete Kealey discussed policy attachment #13 and proposed a change. Change the title to read: Recognition of: "Ill, Honorary, or Deceased members". In essence, adding the recognition of Honorary Members to our club. After discussion a motion was made by Richard Johnson, seconded by Gordon Drake to approve the changes. *Motion approved*

Pete Kealey proposed a change to the board action of 10-9-2005, that the combined positions of Webmaster and Smoke Signal Editor be considered one non-elected position in this Club along with the elected positions of Secretary and Treasurer. All three of these positions receive complimentary dues status as recognition of the time and talent contributed by these members. Under new business, Gary Sullivan proposed that our club establish the "BUG" program. **Bringing Up Grades**. Gary outlined the requirements and cost of the program. Our club budget for 2009-2010 contains a budget of \$100 to cover costs. Motion made by Richard Johnson, seconded by Gordon Drake to have Gary precede with the program and contact the school district with the possibility of using Wilson School as a pilot. *Motion approved*

Motion made by Gordon Drake, seconded by Will Reck to elect Tony Guernsey as secretary for year 2009/2010. *Motion approved*
