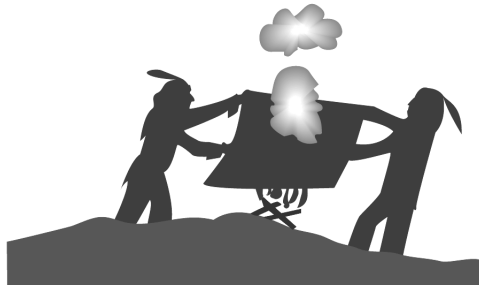

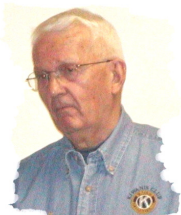

Gordie Drake adjourned the meeting at 9:05

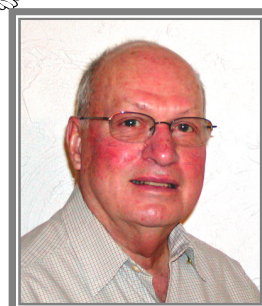
