





Secretary's report of 6-30-10 was submitted at an earlier date. Motion made by Tony Guernsey, seconded by Jerry Langdok to approve the minutes as submitted.

Treasurer's report was submitted by Will Reck. After discussion Will Reck made a motion seconded by Richard Johnson to file the treasurer's report as submitted

Dave Soderberg requested that we purchase a backup flag for Kiwanis Park at a cost of \$58.00. Motion made by Will Reck, seconded by Richard Johnson to give Dave the \$58.00 for the flag.

Pete Kealey discussed the new Kiwanis International Project , ELIMINATE, which will address the problem of tetanus vaccine distribution to 3rd world countries in order to eliminate tetanus in pregnant women and children. Our club will raise money by passing a container weekly. For every \$1,000.00 raised our club will receive a Hixson award that will be used to recognize a club member. More information will be made available in the weeks to come.
