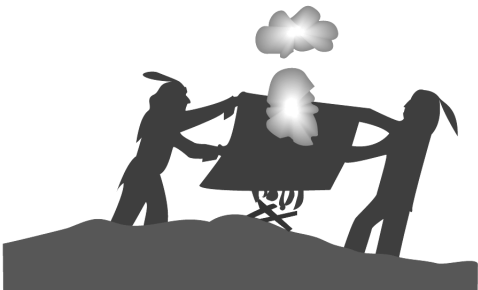

March 28th and 29th.

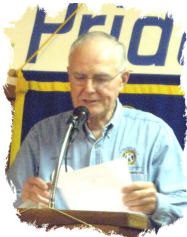
Our Golden “K” provided 60 hours of service and six blood donors.
