





Call to Order: 8:30 a.m. by President Thill

Secretary's Report:

Minutes approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Treasurer's Report:

Will Reck reported that all accounts are very liquid and expressed a desire to allocate funds from the Administrative Account to the Service Account so that Blackhawk Golden K can do more good in the community. The Board will consider this idea at a future Board meeting. Will moved to file the report as submitted. Bob Douglas seconded, motion approved.

Old Business:

Move to Rotary Gardens:

The final meeting date at the Sons of Norway was set for Dec. 12, 2018, with our first meeting at Rotary Gardens to commence on Dec. 19th.

Discussion followed on how to go about determining what needs to be moved to our new location, disposal of what's left, volunteers to help with move and when to do it. Dave Thill said he would get a sign-up sheet for enlisting members to help with the move.

Approval of the 2018/2019 Club Budget:

Will Reck recommended that all Board members study the existing budget and propose any changes or additions at our next Board meeting. New Service Projects would be especially welcomed.

Pickle Ball Memorial Bench for Jim Clark:

The city of Janesville has yet to determine the type of bench for the pickle ball court but wants the benches to be uniform in quality and design. The least expensive bench would cost about \$600 and our club has already approved this expenditure.

Craig Closet:

Jerry Langdok presented the Board with information regarding the Craig Cares campaign that supports our neediest students that otherwise may not have anything for the holidays. Our club has budgeted \$500 towards this project and Jerry would like to have a "Pass the Can" at the Nov. 14th meeting to raise additional funds. There was a motion by Bob Douglas to expand the dollar amount to \$1,400 to help at least 10 students this year. The club would make up the difference. The motion was seconded by Tom Neumann and approved.

Kiwanis Peanut Days

Dave Kemp stated that the final Peanut Days Report has been submitted to Dan Heerey and Will Reck. Our net profit from this project was \$3,580.

New Business:

K-Kids:

K-Kids will not be continuing at Van Buren Elementary School this year.

Since we have paid for and received the materials, the club would like to find another school to take on this project. Tom Neumann said he would contact Madison Elementary School to see if they would be interested.

Salvation Army:

The Salvation Army has a new officer for our area, Major Thomas McDowell. Linda Servais has kindly offered to volunteer as Committee Chairperson to head this committee and get in touch with Major McDowell to coordinate the bell ringing schedule.

Christmas Party:

This years Kiwanis Christmas Party is scheduled for Dec. 12th at Rotary Gardens. Best Events has been contacted in regards to food and beverage service and entertainment is being looked into. Further details will be made known at a later date.

Future Meetings:

Due to the holidays, the Board discussed whether or not to hold meetings on the 26th of Dec. and January 2nd. Wayne Olson made a motion to cancel those meetings, seconded by Don Anderson and passed.

Year End Appeal:

Bob Douglas kindly volunteered to take over for Maury Frey in heading up the "Year End Appeal" letter and mailings.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:15 a.m.

K-Kids is a Kiwanis Club for elementary students. Kiwanis Kids includes three programs for elementary school students. In each, the lessons of leadership and self-development are introduced through learning to plan, setting goals, working with others, and celebrating successes. The programs are broken into three components: service, character education, and academic achievement.

The year has already begun with K-Kids at Lincoln Elementary School. The club will be meeting once a month and has already met in September and October. They have 32 members, Grades 3-5, attending. The faculty advisor is Lisa Jones, but she also is blessed with 3 other staff members assisting. Linda Servais and I also attend as Kiwanis Advisors. This group is very active and has already done crafts with residents at Cedar Crest in October. This club was super active last year and did many local events and one very extensive project helping a school on an island that had been damaged by a hurricane.
