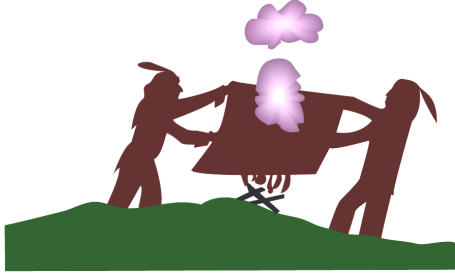

Secretary's Report:

Paul informed the Board of a bill from Kiwanis International that is charging the club for services and supplies that were not ordered or rendered. He said he would contact Kiwanis and try to resolve the incorrect billing. The minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal

Treasurer's Report:

Greg Turco reported that the dues have been paid and gave the Board the November administrative and service account updates. The Administrative Account balance is \$9678 and is down by \$5021 from last month due to our dues payment to Kiwanis International and meeting expenses. Our Service Club Account balance is \$26240 and is up by \$1640 from last month due to Craig's Closet donations.

Greg distributed a proposed fiscal 2022 budget for the service and administrative accounts based on the last two years of activity. Greg made a motion that the Board should approve the proposed 2022 administrative account and was seconded by John Sarnow and passed. Greg also proposed that the Board approve the proposed service account budget for 2022 with the provision to review the account in February and was seconded by Bruce Jorenby and passed.

Tom Neumann recommended to the Board that they should create an audit committee to have a financial review of the past two years since it hasn't been done due to the pandemic and the Board agreed to follow up on this proposal.

—OLD BUSINESS—

Membership:

Operation Push is on hiatus until the advertising campaign begins. The Board also kicked around some ideas on generating new members.

Christmas Party:

Bruce Jorenby gave an update on the menu, entertainment, start time, sign up, etc. and stated that he would have a sign up sheet to pass around to members and announce to the club all the details. The party will be December 14th at the Italian House Restaurant and social hour will start at 5:00 p.m. followed by dinner at 5:30.

—New Business—

Joint Service Luncheon:

Sometime in early 2022, the Noon Lions Club will be hosting a joint service club luncheon and our club will do what it can to help out.

Year End Appeal:

Sometime in early December, the yearend appeal letter will be mailed out to all members in what has become a very successful campaign to help raise funds for our Administrative Account, which allows our club to function properly.

Updated Brochures:

Luci Cramer expressed a need for the club to update our club brochure to reflect our new location, website, etc. and a budget for printing. This is especially important for the recruitment of new members.

Rotary Gardens:

Maury Frey would once again like to present gift cards to the workers of Rotary Gardens for what they do to help our club in holding our weekly meetings. He suggested a \$30, Culvers gift card for the four workers for a total of \$120. John Sarnow made a motion to accept this expenditure and was seconded by Linda Bontly and approved.
