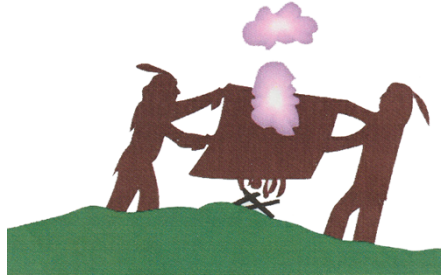

Secretary's Report:

Paul gave an update on membership non-renewals and that he would be distributing a hard copy at the next regular meeting of member addresses, phone numbers and email addresses.

Greg reported an increase to our administrative checking due to the annual dues payments which the club will be billed for in late October. 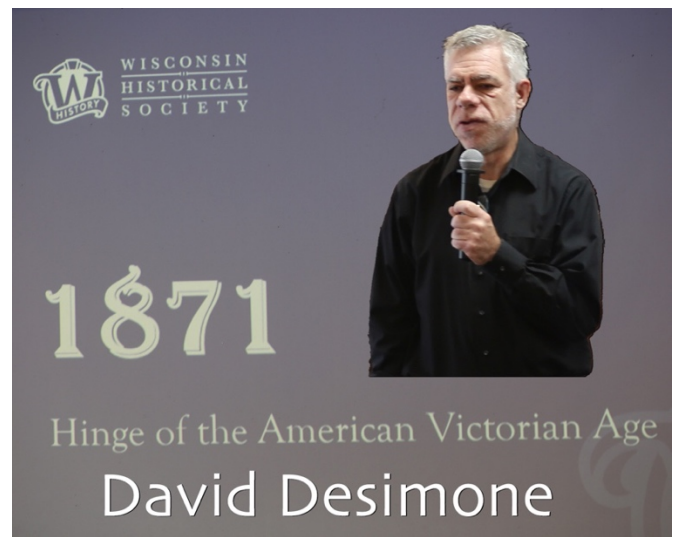
