

Secretary's Report:

Each year, Kiwanis clubs in Wisconsin Upper Michigan are assessed a convention assessment of \$90 per club. This helps to cover expenses related to the District Convention in August and makes registration free for all members of our club. This assessment used to be included as part of our invoice from Kiwanis International. Effective this year, International no longer collects assessments on behalf of the districts and are being billed directly from the Kiwanis District Office. Paul submitted the bill to Greg Turco for payment. The minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Treasurer's Report:

Greg Turco reported that the administrative checking is up about \$2,000 and the Service checking is up about \$8,000 primarily due to sponsorship income for the 2025 Truck on Ice and also the Craig/Parker Closet holiday gifts. Greg made a motion to approve the report and was seconded by Richard Johnson and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Key Club:

Ray Szczepaniak is still looking into the matter of possibly having Milton H.S. participate in a key club.

Vice President:

The position has officially been filled by Tom Neumann.

Craig/Parker Closet:

After much discussion, the board took a motion by Richard Johnson to donate \$1,500 to each of the two high schools and was seconded by Tom Neumann and passed. The budget uses Truck on Ice funds to supplement the Craig/Parker collection. No matching fund calculation is being used this year.

NEW BUSINESS

Inter Club Visits:

Luci Cramer has a Beloit Club visit scheduled for Dec. 17th. We will meet in the El Ray Bowl parking lot at 11:30 for car pool to Beloit.

Kiwanis Grants:

We as a club can apply for a grant of up to \$25,000 but we need to identify a project if we want to proceed and have someone write the grant proposal. Roger Willeford said he would look into this matter further.

Brat Stand:

Roger Willeford mentioned that we could get involved with Festival Foods for a fundraiser involving running a brat stand at Festival Foods. They would provide the stand and the food at cost and it would involve cooking and selling the brats and other items. We could identify what the money would be used for and it would be good publicity and a chance to raise more money. This project could take place anytime from May until the end of summer.

Kandu Christmas Tree:


Ron Shuler said the Blackhawk Golden K Christmas tree is up and available for viewing at Kandu Industries in Milton.
