

Secretary's Report: Paul thought it would be a good idea to clarify our cancellation policy due to inclement weather. Whenever the School District of Janesville cancels school the night before we meet on Wednesdays, Rotary Gardens will be closed and there will be no meeting. If the school district cancels on a Wednesday morning, we will have our meeting due to the difficulty of scheduling regarding guest speakers unless notified via email/phone call. There were no corrections to the minutes and they were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Treasurer's Report: Greg's report stated that the administrative checking balance was up about \$300 due to the timing of our bills. The service checking was up about \$5400 due to \$7000 of T.O.I. income and one of our \$1500 scholarships were paid out. Greg made a motion to approve the report and was seconded by Linda Bontly and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Key Club Update: Ray Szczepaniak informed the board that he heard from all 3 area high schools regarding interest in Key Club. Craig H.S. is interested and will present to the student body for possible involvement but it probably wouldn't begin until next year. Parker was non-committal regarding involvement and Milton has an Inter Act Club with about 10

members. They are not interested in forming a new Key Club but would welcome any financial assistance that we could provide to help them with their community involvement projects. Ray made a motion to allocate \$200 in funds for their Inter Act Club and was seconded by Carl Cramer and approved.

Aktion Club Update: Linda Bontly said that all is going well at Kandu Industries and expressed gratitude for our continued support of the Aktion Club with our \$240 a year subsidy.

NEW BUSINESS

St. Pat's Day Dinner: Our St. Patrick's Day Dinner will be held at the Elk's Club on March 19th with a social hour from 5-5:30 p.m. and dinner at 5:30.

Officer/Director Positions: The club currently has openings for two director positions starting October 2025. Bruce Jorenby and Ryan Lewis have volunteered to fill those positions but if anyone else is interested, please notify one of our board members before the elections held in May. We also have an opening for the position of Vice President.

Club Banner: John Janes said that the club needs a new and better banner for all of our club sponsored events and made a motion to spend \$200 or possibly more to obtain a new banner. The motion was seconded by Tom Neumann and approved.

Flag Box: The flag drop box at Kiwanis Park is starting to look shabby and needs a new paint job. It was suggested that maybe we could make this an art contest at the high schools and get some students involved with this project.

Future Fundraisers: Instead of just one big fundraiser in the winter, it was suggested that maybe we could also do multiple projects throughout the spring, summer and fall seasons. Numerous ideas were presented to the board and this is something the board is very interested to look into for raising a considerable amount of money to help kids and our community.


