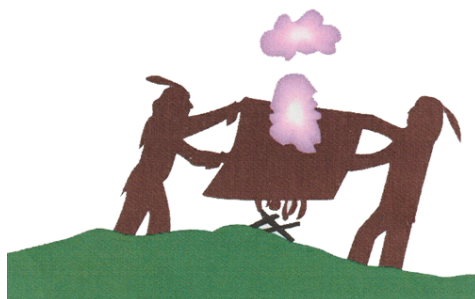

BOARD of DIRECTORS Meeting: 11/26/25

Called to order by President Johnson at 8:20 a.m.

Secretary's Report:

Paul informed the board that as soon as he has all of the information he needs, he will be updating all of the member address and email lists. There is a correction to the minutes. At the October board meeting, the board voted to discontinue funding for the high school scholarships. A week later, the board held a special meeting to hear concerns and was presented with new information regarding scholarships and voted to reverse its decision. Glenn Disrude gave some clarification on the selection process for scholarships and created a committee to help with this process to help ensure that the money goes to students who really need the money. The minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Treasurer's Report:

Greg stated that the administrative checking was up by about \$2000 due to income from dues payments and a \$500 member grant. The service checking account was up by almost \$15000 primarily due to Truck on Ice sponsorship payments. Also included in the report was a down payment on the tree sale and Key Club dues. Greg moved to approve the report and it was seconded by Richard Johnson and approved.

NEW BUSINESS

Bookmobile: Rene Bue from the Hedberg Public Library made a presentation to the board to see if we would be interested in helping to sponsor the new bookmobile. The old

bookmobile was built in 1997 and has over 100,000 miles on it and needs frequent maintenance.

The new one has been fully funded thanks to the generous gifts of the Hedberg Library Foundation and the Friends of Hedberg Library totaling \$250,000. The library's board of trustees voted to fund the remaining \$80,000 using fund balance monies. To keep the bookmobile on the road to support underserved communities, including rural areas, senior centers, schools, and neighborhoods with limited library access, they are looking for sponsors to help fund the remaining budget of \$30,000 that will go towards technology and connectivity, books, movies, community engagement and programs.

The board will discuss this matter at a later board meeting.

Audit Report:

Jim Farrell gave an update and clarification on his 2023/2024 audit report to the board.

Jim said that he talked to the treasurers of numerous clubs and the only treasurer to use computer checks was the former treasurer of Noon Kiwanis. He felt there was an advantage to doing computer checks because of a better audit trail. Jim conceded that this may not be practical for Golden Kiwanis. Jim also stated that per best accounting practices for service clubs, the treasurer should receive and reconcile bank statements or write checks, but not both. Currently the treasurer is doing both.

The treasurer has recommended these duties be split and Jim agrees with that. Tom Neumann made a motion to approve the report and was seconded by Roger Willeford and approved.

Christmas Party:

This years Christmas party will be Dec. 17th at the Elks Club beginning at 5:00 p.m.

Kiwanis International Convention:

For anyone interested in attending the convention, it will be held June 24th-27th in Manilla, Philippines. Registration opens on Dec. 1, 2025.

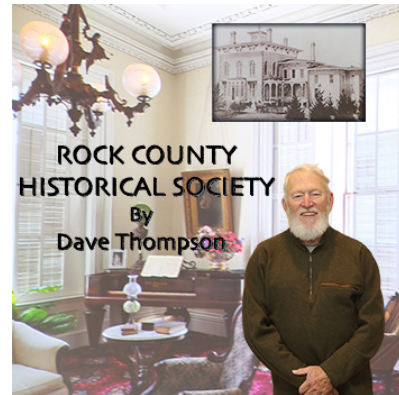
